The new 112th Congress has convened this month in Washington, D.C. and the ICCFA is once again asking your help to update our enclosed Congressional and Federal Communications Networking Survey. The information you provide to us will be kept confidential and helps in securing Capitol Hill support for legislation and regulations affecting your business operations.

Every two years a new Congress convenes and power centers can shift not only from one party to another, but from one individual to another as committee chairmanships change and legislative priorities are re-established. Given the current economic crisis, the concerns of Congress and the regulatory agencies will be focused on the business operations of both large and small companies. Taxation, union representation, and health care will also be among the many issues confronting this Congress. Of course, the so-called "Bereaved Consumer Bill of Rights Act," may be reintroduced into this Congress, which would have a significant adverse impact on our members should it become law.

Many legislative and regulatory proposals do not specifically target our industry, but our members can be dramatically affected nevertheless. An important part of the ICCFA's responsibilities is to act as a watchdog of Capitol Hill to prevent our members from being adversely impacted by new laws or regulations.
